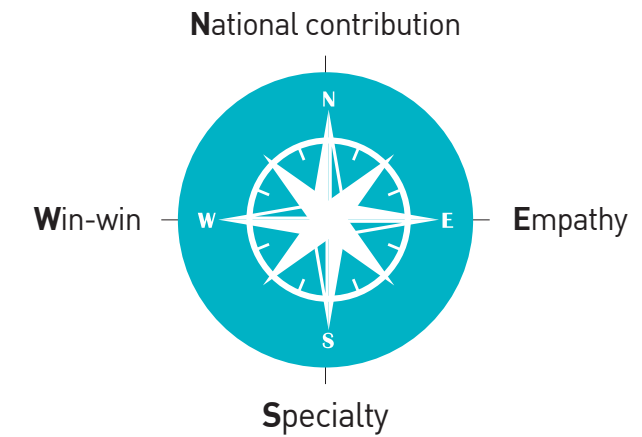
Vision

Becoming a world class fiscal institution by focusing on digitalized financial information management.

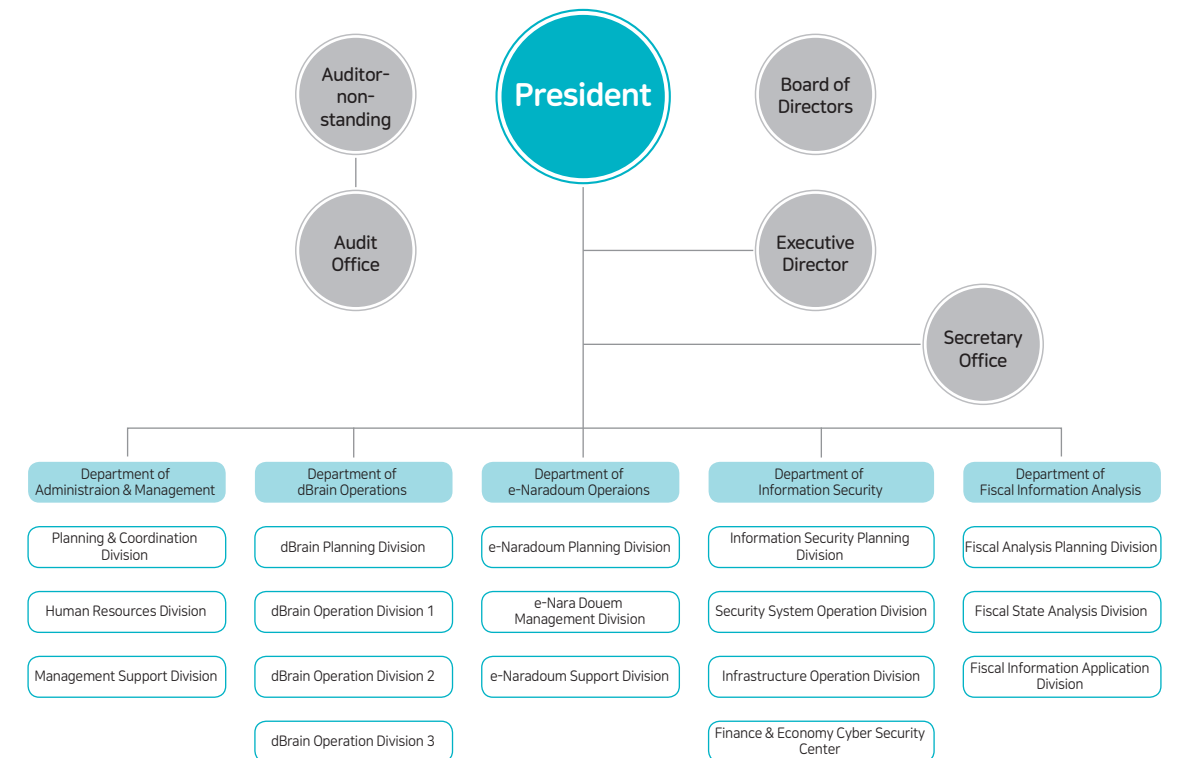
Mission

Organizational Chart



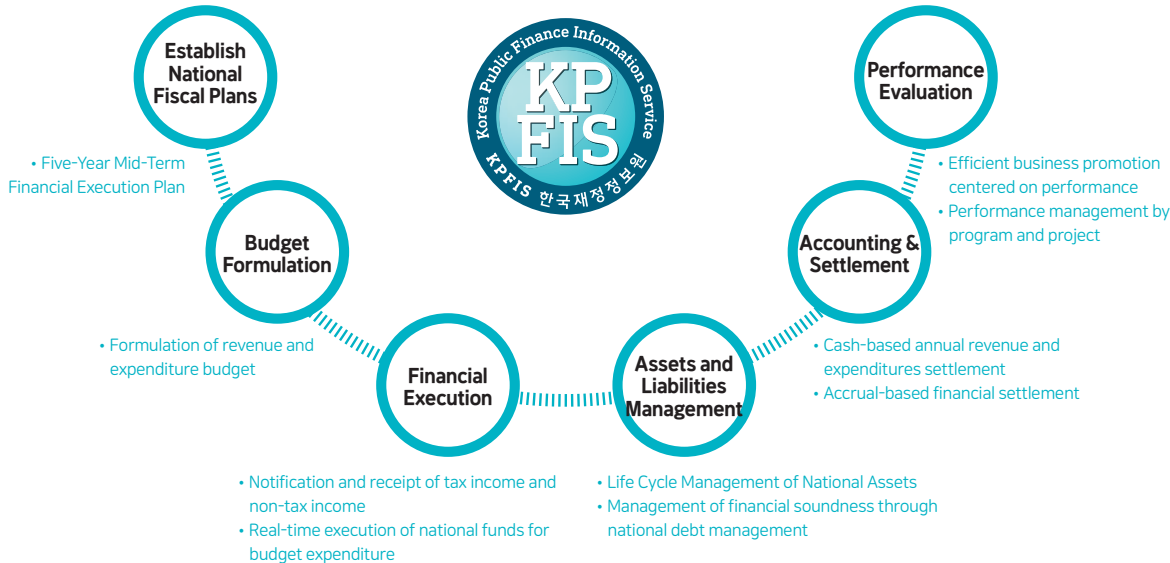
'dBrain', the Mainstay of National Fiscal Business

dBrain Operation Summary

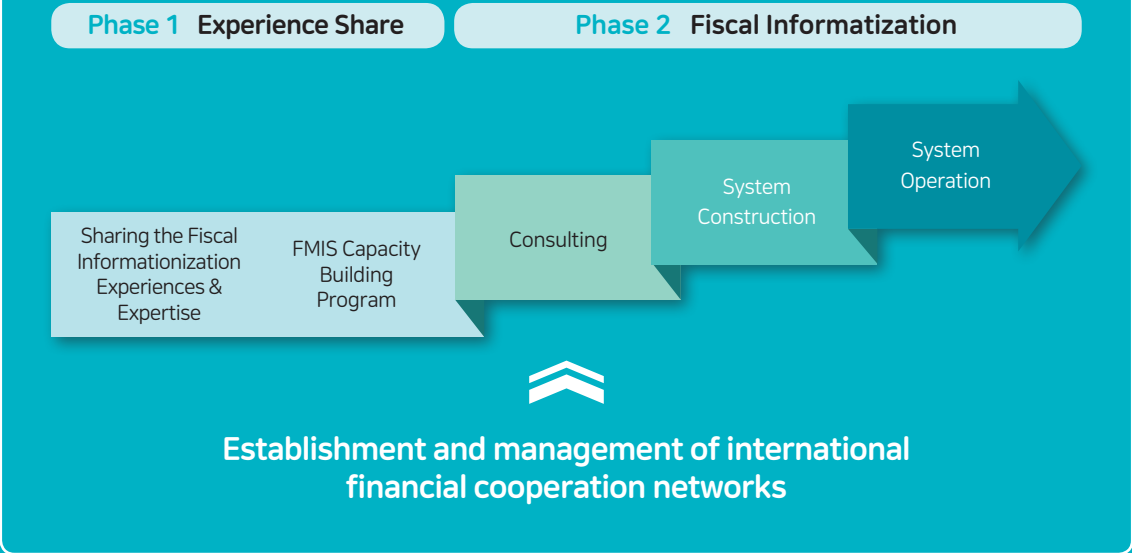
(Unit: Daily average, as of end of December 2018)

- Cooperation with international development financial institutions for informatization in developing countries.

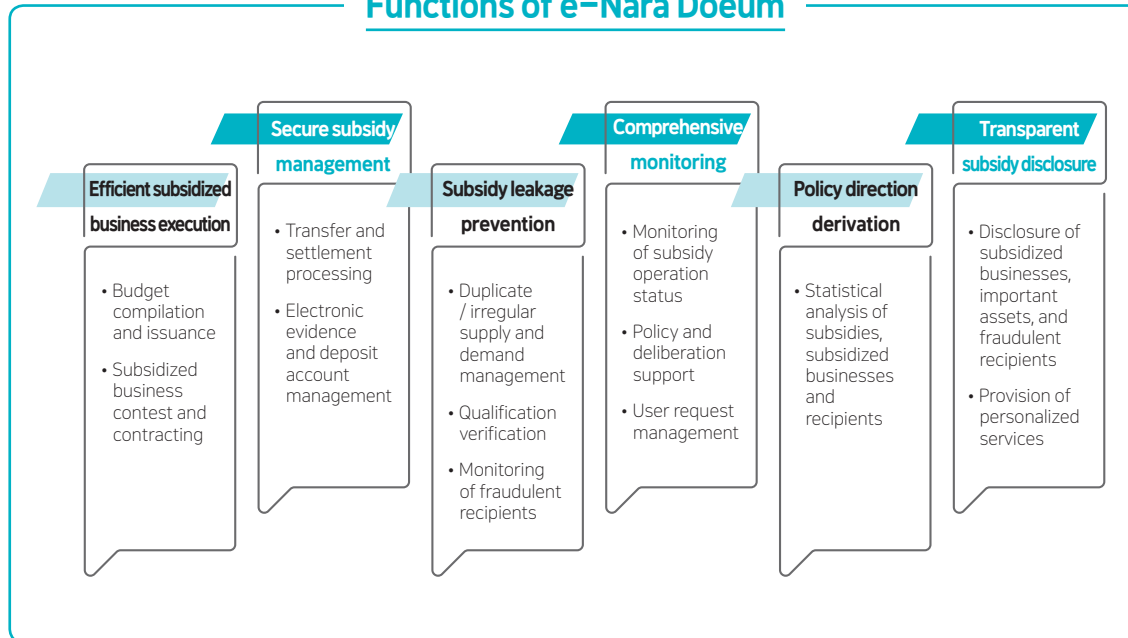
International Cooperation Roadmap

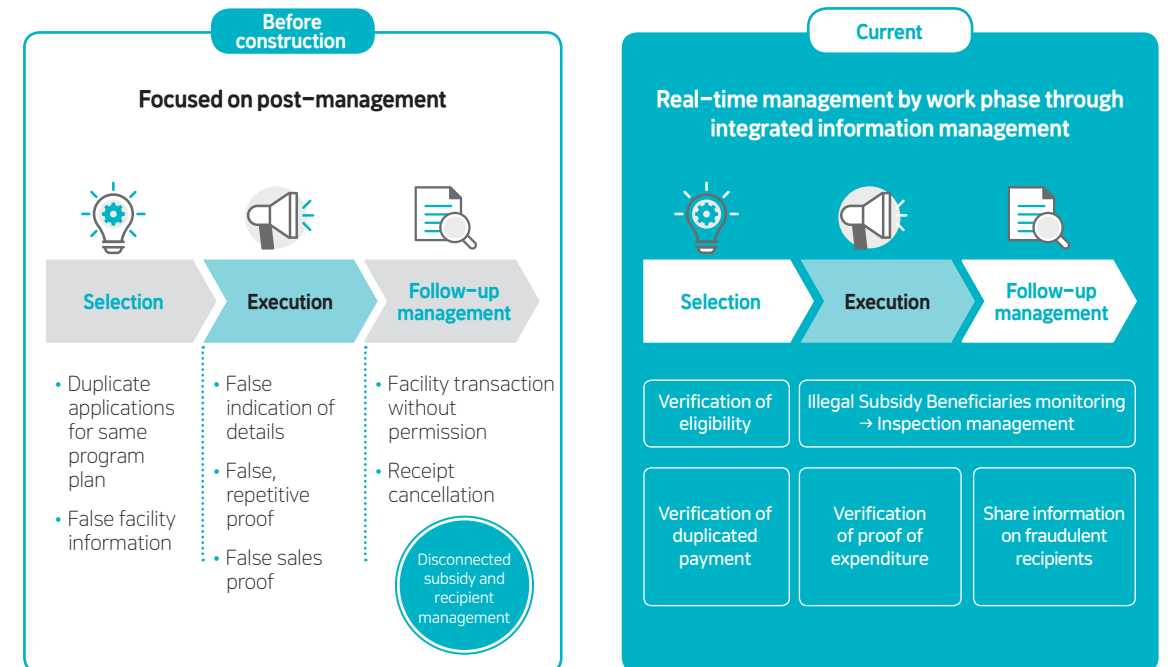
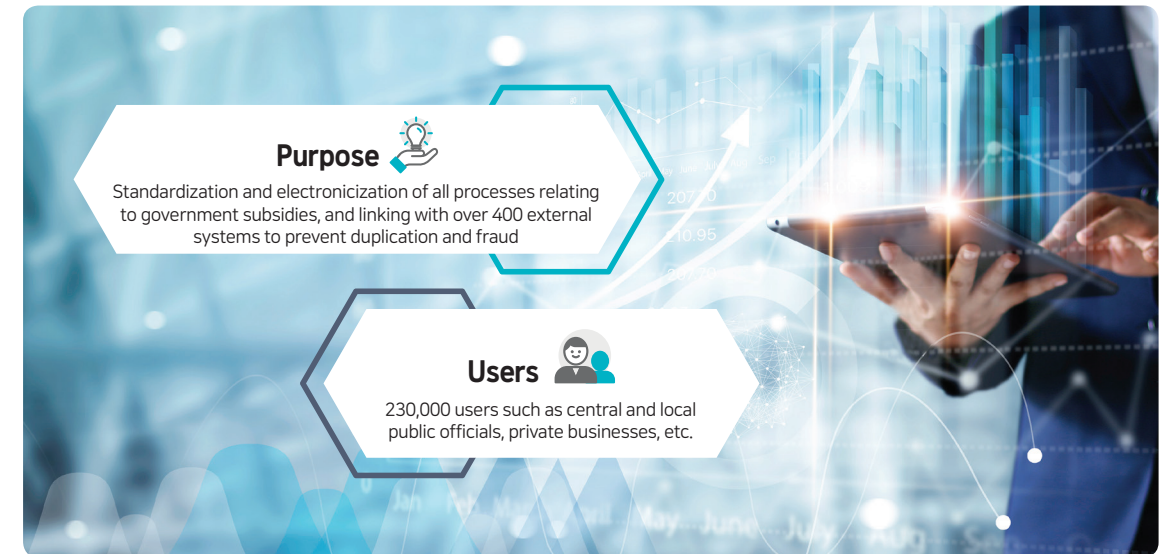

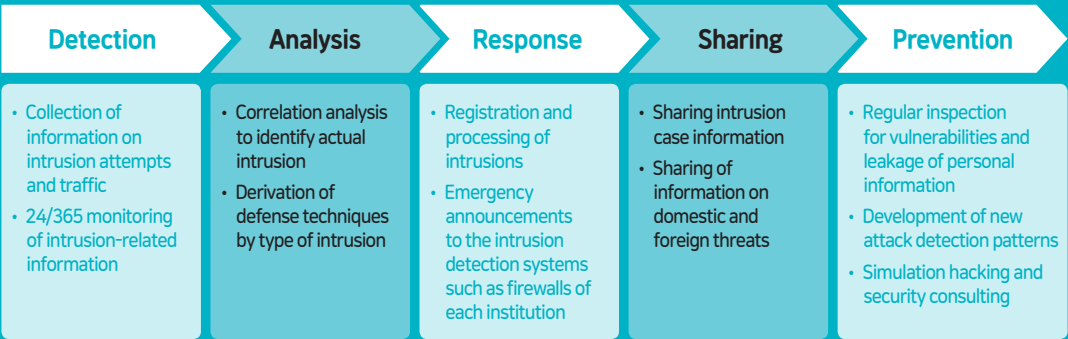


Cyber Security for Government Finance and Economy Sector

Main workflow

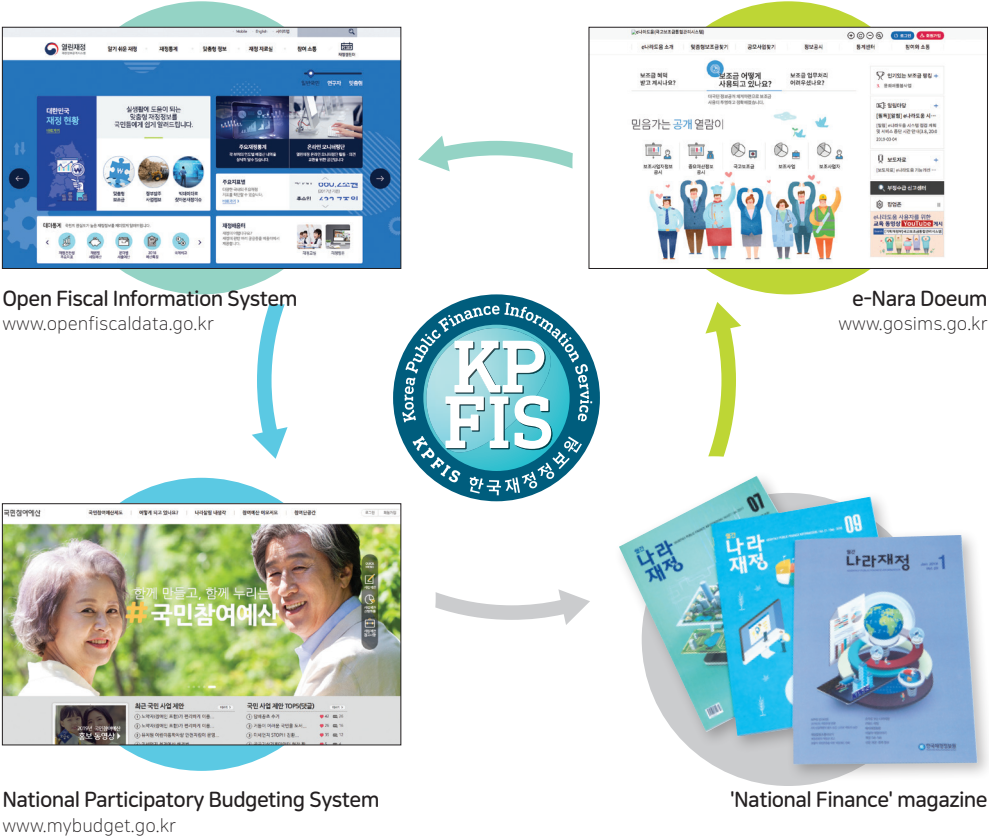

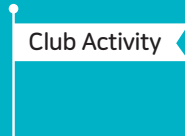
